## Refund Policy for the 2020 Massive Murray Paddle (Murray Marathon):

Please read carefully

I understand that if I withdraw from the Massive Murray Paddle (also known as MMP, or The Event) up to and until **11:59pm Friday October 16, 2020**, there is a cancellation fee that applies. **You will be returned 70% of the entry fee paid.**

Should I withdraw from **12.00am on Saturday October 17, 2020** onwards for any reason (including, but not limited to, medical reasons), **there is no refund of any portion of my entry fee**, subject to applicable laws.

If you need to withdraw from **12.00am on Saturday October 17, 2020** onwards, then you can transfer your MMP entry to the Massive Murray Paddle in 2021 without penalty.

I agree that in the event of Event cancellation due to storm, rain, flood, inclement weather, winds or other Acts of God conditions, my Event entry fee shall not be refundable to me, subject to applicable laws.

I agree that if there are any government restrictions imposed on the running of the event, cancellation of the event or restrictions in travel in getting to the event, then my Event entry fee shall not be refundable to me. In this situation, my MMP entry can be transferred to the 2021 event without penalty.

The update in the terms for the 2020 Massive Murray Paddle have been modified to fall in line with the guidelines from the ACCC / Australian Competition and Consumer Commission.
